

International Conference of the French Finance Association will award two prizes for the best theses in corporate finance and in financial markets

During the <u>36th International Conference of the French Finance Association</u>, two best theses prizes will be awarded:

- One for the best thesis in Financial Markets. The prize rewards theoretical, empirical, experimental or historical work on capital markets and asset pricing, including derivatives markets, risk management and asset management. This year's jury is presided over by Marie-Claude Beaulieu (Université Laval);
- One for the best thesis in Corporate Finance. The prize rewards theoretical, empirical, experimental or historical work on corporate finance, including financial institutions and entrepreneurial finance. This year's jury is presided over by Aurélien Philippot (Université Laval).

Eligible theses must have been defended between January 2018 and December 2018.

Applications should be sent to <a href="mailto:affi2019@fsa.ulaval.ca">affi2019@fsa.ulaval.ca</a> before **February 15th** and should include an electronic copy of the thesis, a 3-page summary of the thesis and, if any, the pre-defence reports and the report of the jury.

As a reminder, the deadline to submit a paper for the international AFFI conference is **January 31st**.
